


"Health and physical education for pupil of both sexes shall be established and provided in all public schools of this state."

HIV Mandate

Public Act 165 and 166 of 2004

School districts are required to teach about dangerous communicable diseases, including, but not limited to HIV/AIDS and instruction must be offered at least once a year at every building level.

Sex Education Law

Public Act 165 and 166 of 2004

If a school district chooses to teach Sex Education, they must have a Sex Education Advisory Board (SEAB) and must follow all other law related to sex education instruction including parent/ guardian notice and formal board approval.
