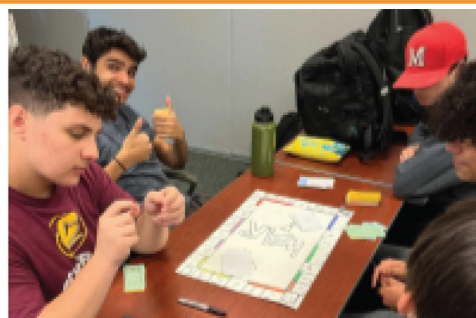
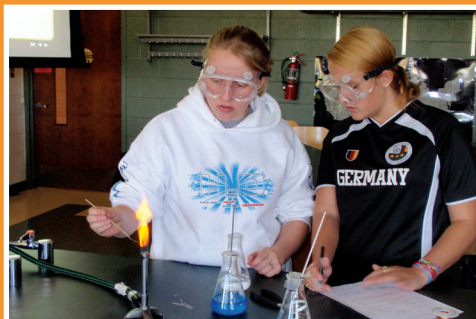

MCMC is on the main campus of Monroe County Community College. While our students take classes in multiple buildings on the campus, MCMC is located in the basement of the Campbell Learning Resource Center (the Library), 1555 S. Raisinville Rd., Monroe, MI 48161.

Students can enter Monroe County Middle College in the 9th, 10th, or 11th grades to pursue a rigorous curriculum and receive their high school diplomas. They can also earn up to 60 transferable college credit hours or an associate degree and, or a certificate.
