## TWO SEATS OPEN ON MCISD BOARD OF EDUCATION

Two positions on the **Monroe County Intermediate School District Board of Education** are open for nomination. Both seats are six-year terms; beginning July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2029.

M.C.I.S.D. Board members are elected by a panel comprised of representatives from the nine constituent local public school districts. These individuals are appointed by the local districts via adoption of a local district resolution that names the representative and identifies the candidate for whom that person is directed to vote on the first ballot. The election will be held on Monday, June 5, 2023, at the Monroe County I.S.D.

A person interested in applying for any of these positions must be a registered voter and must be a resident within one of the M.C.I.S.D.'s nine local school districts. According to Revised School Code 380.416, not more than 2 members of the intermediate school board shall be from the same school district.

Anyone who is interested in serving as a board member may submit the required petitions from the Monroe County Clerk's Office. These petitions must be signed by at least 40 (but no more than 100) registered voters in the M.C.I.S.D.'s service area, which covers the school districts of Monroe County. Candidates must file petition signatures or a \$100 nonrefundable filing fee and an Affidavit of Identity with the county clerk. Candidates must also furnish proof of identity when filing for office. All candidates must be residents of Monroe County. Payments can be made in the form of cash, credit card or money order.

All materials are available from the Monroe County Clerk's office, located at 106 E. First Street in Monroe, and completed forms must be returned there by 4 p.m. on Monday, May 8, 2023.

The **Monroe County Intermediate School District** is Monroe County's regional educational service agency, providing special education, administrative, curriculum, and technological services to Monroe County's pre-K-12 public, private, charter, and parochial schools.
