1 What is PAC?

PAC is the acronym for Parent Advisory Committee. The PAC consists of parents of students with disabilities from each local school district.

2 What does the PAC do?

- The PAC participates in the development of the intermediate school district's plan or modifications to the plan for the delivery of special education services in the county.
- The PAC may provide advisory input on any matters that the committee deems appropriate to the improvement of special education services within the intermediate school district.
- The MCISD PAC, in partnership with the MCISD, offers parent information nights throughout the year. We listen to the community to see what needs there are and try to bring in experts in the field to support families with education and training. We spread the news about exciting things happening in special education both at the state level and in our own community through the PAC Perspective Newsletter.
