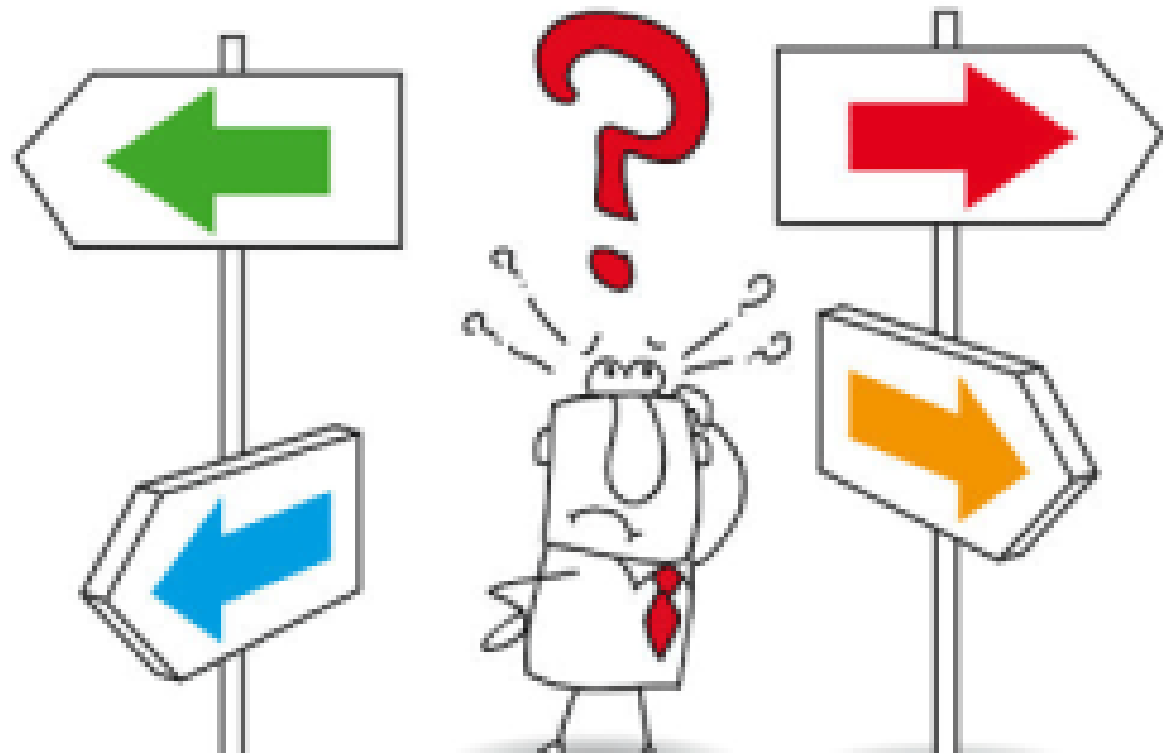

It is more comprehensive than a schedule of classes because it includes information a student can use to make wise choices about postsecondary options.



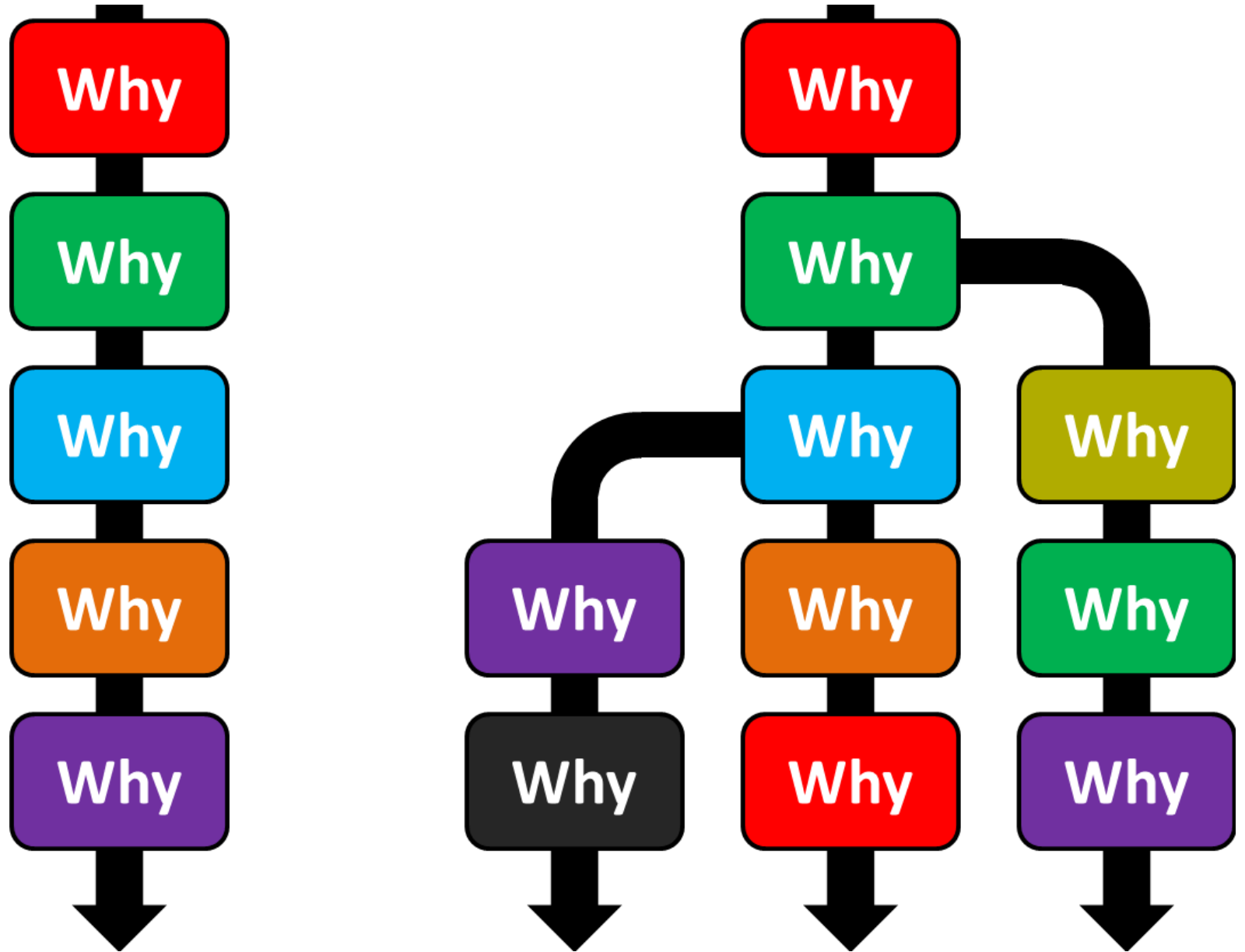


WHAT IS AN EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN (EDP)?

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WHY HAVE AN EDP?

The State of Michigan requires that students must be given the opportunity to create an EDP beginning in the 7th grade and revises it appropriately throughout high school. An EDP is designed to assist students to identify career development goals as they relate to academic requirements, which may be fulfilled through career and technical education.



HOW CAN STUDENTS START/UPDATE THEIR EDP?

School Counselors and the MCISD Transition Coordinator has access to EDPs: Career Cruising and/or Naviance. They may assist in setting up students' account to initiate and/or update their EDPs.
